

## AHS Volleyball Summer League 2017

Welcome To & Thank You for participating in the Auburn HS Volleyball Summer League. The focus of this league is to provide you and your teams an opportunity to play in a competitive learning environment. My hope is that the atmosphere will be relaxed, but place our athletes in the competitive environment that we know only takes place on game night. Listed below is the basic rule structure of the league. Games will be played on Tuesday nights, starting 7/11/17 through 7/25/17.

The league will be structured in pools of 3 teams, playing a Round Robin each night. We will reshuffle the pools each week. **Matches will start @ 6:00, 7:00, and 8:00.** We will **play all three sets of each match, regardless of who wins the first 2 sets.** This will ensure that every team plays 6 sets each Tuesday. **The first 2 sets will start @ 4 points and progress to 25 with a 27 point cap. The 3<sup>rd</sup> set will start @ zero, and play to 15, with a 17 point cap. Games will start on the hour but may start earlier if both teams agree.** On the final Tuesday (7/26/16), we will play a bracketed tournament, with seeding based on each team's overall SET win/loss record. There will be a T-shirt awarded to the Championship Team.

**As to warm-ups, for first match of the evening only, each team will receive 4 minutes on court alone, serve time to be included. Timeouts- 2 per game, 30 seconds in duration. There will be unlimited subs.** Because some teams will be short players at times, we will not worry if a player goes in the game in a position that she was not at first placed. **AHS will provide Liberos with a pinney, so that no team jersey/shirt will be required.** Teams must play with a minimum of 5 players. You may also use players from other teams (example- pull a JV kid to Varsity if they are not playing). **No jewelry- same policy as during the school season.** Proper attire and appropriate tennis shoes must be worn at all times by the players.

Water ONLY allowed on the sidelines/in the bench area. No sports drinks please.

Game balls are to be furnished by the teams playing on the various courts. **If your team is assigned refereeing responsibilities, you must provide a down official, 2 linespersons, and a score flipper.**
