

WAYNE GARDNER MATCH POINT HONOR AWARD

The Wayne Gardner Match Point Award is designed to honor persons who, by their leadership and devotion to the sport of volleyball, have made an outstanding and noteworthy contribution to the advancement of volleyball in the Tacoma-Pierce County area. The criteria in recommending recipients for this award is as follows:

1. Be recommended by Tacoma-Pierce County Volleyball Officials Board (TPCVOB) or other Pierce County Volleyball Related Organization. (PCVRO)
2. Active at least 10 years as a coach or official. Official must currently hold or have held a State or National rating.
3. Served as a member of the TPCVOB or PCVRO Executive Board.
4. Exhibited a professional attitude and enthusiasm for volleyball.
5. Practiced proper interpretation and administration.
6. Made contributions to TPCVOB or other PCVRO.
7. Officiated coordinated or coached at high school state championship.
8. Demonstrated citizenship and good character.

The TPCVOB Executive Board will review any special recommendation for an award not fulfilling all criteria.
